

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

In 2018, New Covenant Schools in Lynchburg Virginia, requested our services to help them develop an in-house scuba program with their students. Since then, we have refined and enhanced the model, allowing us to serve large numbers of students. The ability to do this sets us apart from other dive shops. We have developed a system that addresses the logistical complexities of working with many students at one time.

The training is enhanced at the school, within a club setting. On club days the students meet to get additional classroom instruction. This instruction can consist of guest speakers, exploration of various types of equipment, support with their scuba academics, briefing/debriefing various training dives, etc. These club days start at the beginning of the school year and continue throughout the completion of the training. This allows the students the time needed to fully explore the numerous opportunities and challenges in scuba diving

Scuba diving offers many options and possibilities for future careers. We recommend dedicating some time to discovering the interests of your students and how scuba diving may be able to enhance their future careers.



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SCUBA CLUB LOGISTICS AND STAFFING

School Administration

- Assigns a lead teacher for the program
- Meets with all parties at the beginning of the year
- Agrees to all legal documents and payment contracts
- Reviews and selects dive travel locations based on recommendation of the dive instructor
- Solidifies a yearly schedule for the training

Lead teacher for the school

- Collate all legal documents and releases
- Distributes and collects all required documents from parents and students
- Primary contact for the scuba instructor
- School trip leader
- Direct communication with parents and students
- Attends necessary training with the students
- Classroom instruction that enhances student learning (i.e., marine science, ocean conservation etc.)
- Liaison between the dive center and the school
- Travels with the students
